

Foil Fish

I have done this project with various age groups and it's always a success.

You need:

Foil

Markers (permanent work best)

Texture maker - netting from a bag of onions, bubble wrap, bumpy fabric, etc.

Scissors (optional)

Place a texture maker under a sheet of foil and color with marker, rubbing to press the foil and show texture.

Try different texture combinations.

The fish can be cut out and glued onto a drawing of a fish bowl. If you color two pieces (opposite directions) and glue them together, they can hang from fishing line.
